The priming in the tube is a composition of aalt-peter, powder, and brimstone. The tin was pitched and wrapped round with rope yarn, which was cemented with rosin and tar. Hound the tin and in the rope-yarn, twelve pieces of iron were planted. From the lighting of the fuse to the explosion might take about half-minute. If one of them were to be exploded in a room where there were a number of persons, it would produce great destruction. The pieces of iron would fly about like bullets. The witness here opened another of the grenades for the satisfaction of the jury: it was composed in the manner already described.
